4 Hot New Hotels Welcome the Chic to the City

THE 72-ROOM

Wythe Hotel (rooms from \$399, 80 Wythe Ave.) opened in Williamsburg, Brooklyn, a year ago in a 1901 barrel factory, featuring a sixth-floor rooftop bar and the acclaimed Reynard restaurant with a rusticated menu. In the rooms are custom beds from reclaimed pine and floor-to-13-foot-ceiling windows. "The design is so special, the restaurant has really great food and a rad vibe, and you can't beat the neighborhood," says A-list L.A.-based stylist **Ilaria Urbinati**. ...

Refinery Hotel (rooms from \$279, 63 W. 38th St.), opening in May, is a turn-of-the-century hat factory transformed into an industrial chic hotel with a rooftop bar. Nestled in Manhattan's Fashion District, the 197-room hotel features sewing-machine-inspired desks that nod to the building's past. ... Part of Hilton's luxury line and located in downtown's Battery Park, the **Conrad Hotel** (rooms from \$329, 102 North End Ave.) has 463 suites, its own barber-shop and Mediterranean-focused restaurant Atrio, situated in the center of the 15-story atrium lobby. ... Opened in February in Greenwich Village, the 113-room **Jade Hotel** (rooms from \$323, 52 W. 13th St.), is a jewel box of 1920s Parisian-inspired rooms in reds and golds.
